Be prepared to justify your grading with specific observations if required.

1. Use of creative thinking skills in planning and writing.				
2. Sense of purpose and audience in communication.				
3. Effective use of writing techniques (e.g. word choice, variety, and use of imagery and contrasts).				
4. Effective development of logical organization and smooth transitions.				
5. Effective use of inquiry skills to locate appropriate information.				
6. Knowledge of role play form.				
7. Effective presentation of key ideas and information relevant to the roles.				
8. Effective use of oral communication techniques.				
9. Effective use of physical expressions (e.g. gestures, facial expressions, body language, and voice) to enhance role.				
10. Portrayed roles with credibility (e.g. thoughts, attitudes, and feelings of the characters).				
11. Showed understanding of issues, ideas and information.				
12. Effective development of main ideas, interesting details, terminology and supporting information.
