Benjamin Weems, 45 black, widow, servant in 12th ward, precinct 4

1880 U.S. Census – Leonardtown, St. Mary’s Maryland

Augustus Weems, single, 19, born Maryland, Hostler, Both parents born in Maryland, Lives with J. Frank Ford & family, Clerk of Court.

Death Certificate – District of Columbia

Catherine A. Weems died July 27, 1915

Occupation – nurse, Birthplace – Maryland, Birthplace of parents – Maryland, length of residence in D.C. – 13 yrs.
